Tamper Resistant Prescriptions Provider Compliance Referral Form

Pursuant to federal law (H.R. 2206 / Public Law 110-28, U.S. Troop Readiness, Veterans' Care, Katrina Recovery, and Iraq Accountability Appropriations Act, 2007), effective April 1, 2008, prescribing practitioners will be required to use tamper-resistant prescription paper when writing a prescription for any drug for Medicaid recipients that meet specific federal requirements.

Upon request, the Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) will help educate prescribers who continue to use prescription paper that does not meet the new federal guidelines. If you believe HHSC's educational assistance may benefit a prescriber's compliance with the new federal law, complete the prescriber and pharmacy information on this form and fax it to 1-817-321-8064.
